On December 5th, join us for a laid back discussion with Prof Joel Schindall of the the Department of EECS!

The Academics, Research, and Career Committee and the Muddy Charles Pub Board of Governors of the MIT Graduate Student Council jointly bring together grad students and professors (or industry professionals) over warm meals and cold beers/soda in a program called Profs-On-Tap. These events are meant to provide a relaxed atmosphere for students to get to know a professional or professor and learn about their career trajectory. Discussion should not be research focused!
