Georgia Tech Eckert Postdoctoral Fellowship Program 2019

The School of Chemical & Biomolecular Engineering at Georgia Tech will offer multiple fully funded postdoctoral fellowships in 2019. Recipients of these positions will be designated Eckert Postdoctoral Fellows. Applications for this position are open for researchers interested in working with any of the 35+ core faculty in the School.

Features of this fellowship include:

- Full financial support for 18 months
- Funds available for travel, materials and supplies
- Optional involvement in teaching activities

This position would be ideal for candidates interested in pursuing academic positions in the future. More than 130 PhD students or postdocs from our program have joined academia since 2000.

Applications for this program must be made on behalf of a candidate by a faculty member from Georgia Tech. To apply, the faculty member will need to submit (i) a CV from the candidate, (ii) a one page statement of research goals from the candidate and faculty member emphasizing the new nature of research directions for the faculty member, and (iii) a one page statement of career goals from the candidate.

Applications for positions beginning in 2019 must be received by December 15, 2018, with decisions on awards to be made by early February 2019.
