The RFAs will foster a sense of community and belonging, introduce students to key concepts, problem solving, and study skills to help them prepare for academics at MIT, introduce students to MIT offices/resources and aid in their understanding of services at MIT, build a strong support network with students before the beginning of their first year, and support students' exploration of the surrounding Boston area to make MIT feel like home.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

Helping incoming MIT first year students to master problem-solving techniques, enhancing scholars' oral and written communication skills, teaching scholars about Institute resources critical to success at MIT, cultivating peer, staff, and faculty relationships as well as a network of support, develop scholars' academic, leadership, interpersonal, and professional skills, leading weekly recitations, holding office hours, being available to schedule one-on-one in-person or Zoom meetings upon request, reviewing class material, assisting with non-academic workshops throughout the summer.
